

# 2025 Battle of the Books



Dear Parents of rising 6th graders,

We are continuing our Battle of the Books competition with other Christian schools in Palm Beach County in the fall of 2025! Last year, we had more than 20 students participate, and we would love to see that number grow this year!

Battle of the Books is a reading and recall competition that is hosted by Boca Christian School and Kings Academy. The actual competition will take place in the fall of 2025 (tentatively October). Students will be organized into teams. Teams are composed of a mix of 3rd, 4th, and 5th grade students, with 6th grade students as coaches. When school begins in the fall, students will practice once a week after school for approximately 4-6 weeks.

Since the schools running the competition do not have 6th grade as part of their elementary, 6th grade does not have a book list and cannot compete on a team. To give our 6th graders an opportunity to participate in this event, they can be coaches of our 3rd-5th grade teams.

Students who would like to be a coach should read all 6 books from one of the grade levels. They should type 10 short answer questions for each book that can be answered with the title of the book. An example question would be: "In which book does the main character search for a little girl lost in a snowstorm?" (from *Loser by Jerry Spinelli*). Please provide the answer for each question.

Students are encouraged to read as many books as they can from the full list. Students who read all 18 books from the entire 3-5th grade list will receive a pizza lunch if questions are written for each book. The best time to read is over summer break. We recommend checking at your local public library for your student to begin reading over the summer. We will also have copies of some of the books available to check out from the elementary office.

The first competition will be held during chapel time in late September with our school teams; then the final will be against other schools who are members of Christian Schools of Palm Beach County.

**To summarize, if your child would like to participate, he/she should:**

- Read all 6 books from one of the grade levels on the book list
- Type 10 questions and answers for each book
- Look for an email about registering for the team once school begins in August
- Optional: read all 18 books and write 10 questions for each one for a special lunch when we return to school
