

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. What are my learning options now?

Students will have two options, all day on campus or e-learning.

2. What will a classroom look like?

Classrooms in K5-8th will have students in Pods (groups of 3-4) and those Pods will be socially distanced from one another.

3. What will lunch look like? Where will students eat?

All students will eat in the cafeteria during their lunch period.

- K5-6th will sit in Pods and shields will be used to separate them.
- Jr. and Sr. High students will sit in every other seat.
- Sr. High will have two lunches to allow social distancing.

4. How many students will be in a typical classroom?

K5 & 1st will have no more than 20 students.
2nd - 4th will have no more than 22 students.
5th & 6th will have no more than 25 students.
7th - 12th have no more than 25 and the average is 17.

5. Will students still have to wear masks?

Yes, students need to wear a mask or face shield except during lunch or rigorous activity (PE/Recess). We will continue to recognize the exceptions outlined in the Palm Beach County mask mandate.

6. Will students have homework on Wednesday nights?

Students will not have homework on Wednesday night or tests on Thursdays to allow them to attend Church services online or in-person if available.
