DEEP ROOTS BIBLE

1ST GRADE CURRICULUM

DEEP ROOTS BIBLE

MATH 1 – BJU PRESS

Students develop number sense and apply math concepts—such as addition, subtraction, time, and measurement—through a biblical worldview, emphasizing themes of exploration, work, and stewardship.

SCIENCE 1

Students will explore space, weather, climate, light and sound, the Earth's surface, and the survival of living things. They will learn how these concepts reflect God's creation and how to use this knowledge to glorify Him.

SOCIAL STUDIES 1

Students will explore topics like citizenship, family, community, economics, geography, and holidays through a biblical worldview, highlighting God's design for society and government.

2ND GRADE CURRICULUM

DEEP ROOTS BIBLE

Deep Roots Bible Curriculum is an Apologetics and Worldview Bible Curriculum designed to equip students with the tools and training to stand firm in today's cultural challenges.

MATH 2 – BJU PRESS

Students will learn to understand place value, addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division. Basic word problems are introduced to exercise students' problem-solving skills.

ENGLISH 2 -EASY GRAMMAR

READING 2 – BJU PRESS

Students will be equipped to enjoy lifelong reading, analyze and interpret texts in various genres, evaluate all they read from a biblical worldview, and become effective communicators.

SCIENCE 2 – BJU PRESS

Students will learn how to use the science process or inquiry skills to learn and talk about God's creation. They will learn about living things, plants, habitats, fossils, and dinosaurs, the layers and features of the earth, how the earth moves, natural resources, forces and motion, and how the body works.

HERITAGE STUDIES 2 -BJU PRESS

Students learn to evaluate society and their role in it through the lens of God's Word. They will develop a Christian worldview of communities, government, buying and selling, and American culture.

3RD GRADE CURRICULUM

DEEP ROOTS BIBLE

Deep Roots Bible Curriculum is an Apologetics and Worldview Bible Curriculum and is designed to equip students with the tools and training to stand firm in the face of today's cultural challenges.

MATH 3 – BJU PRESS

Students will learn place value, multiplication, division, and fractions. They will be challenged to think more deeply about their calculations and the implications of math on their worldview. They will focus on four basic themes: math is a tool to help people work, math shows how the world is designed, math helps people help people, and math has limits.

ENGLISH 3 – EASY GRAMMAR

READING 3 – BJU PRESS

Students will be equipped to enjoy lifelong reading, analyze and interpret texts in various genres, evaluate all they read from a biblical worldview, and become effective communicators.

SCIENCE 3 – BJU PRESS

Science 3 helps students develop a biblical worldview related to various science concepts. Students learn where our world came from and how it has changed. They learn to defend the truth that God created all things and how to answer why people are essential. Units cover physical, earth-space, and life sciences.

HERITAGE STUDIES 3 – BJU PRESS

Heritage Studies 3 teaches students to develop a biblical worldview of geography. Students will learn to evaluate historical events in United States history from the Constitutional Convention through the Civil War.

4TH GRADE CURRICULUM

DEEP ROOTS BIBLE

Deep Roots Bible Curriculum is an Apologetics and Worldview Bible Curriculum designed to equip students with the tools and training to stand firm in today's cultural challenges.

MATH 4 – BJU PRESS

Students will be encouraged to compute accurately as they apply their knowledge of place value to multiplication and division. They will also be encouraged to use reasoning skills to estimate answers, be introduced to STEAM activities, and develop a better understanding of fractions, geometry, measurements, and pre-algebra skills.

ENGLISH 4 – BJU PRESS

Students will review and broaden their foundational knowledge of English conventions and learn how to apply grammar, mechanics, and usage to writing and speaking. This course offers six writing projects and journaling practice to help students apply the writing process and grammar skills. They will develop their speaking, writing, visual, and digital literacy skills, and research through biblical worldview themes that will increase their sense of wonder at God's gift of language.

READING 4 – BJU PRESS

Students will be equipped to enjoy lifelong reading, analyze and interpret texts in a variety of genres, evaluate all that they read from a biblical worldview, and become effective communicators.

SCIENCE 4 – BJU PRESS

Students will learn about life through the context of a biblical worldview. Using their scientific knowledge, inquiry skills, and engineering skills, they will discover living things, energy, and the earth's surface. They will also explore plants, animals, humans, waves, and natural resources to further analyze their cycles and patterns. They will discover more of the world around them and deepen their knowledge of the Creator.

OUR STATE NOTEBOOK – A BEKA

Students explore Florida history in 4th grade, learning about its geography, early inhabitants, colonization, statehood, and key events, all through a biblical worldview that highlights God's hand in history.

5TH GRADE CURRICULUM

BIBLE 5 – POSSESSING THE LAND – POSITIVE ACTION FOR CHRIST

Students will develop an understanding of the Old Testament, which offers countless examples of God's power and love. They will study Abraham and his family, the Israelites' journey from Egypt through the wilderness, the early kings of Israel, the division of the kingdom, the Babylonian Exile, and the Poetic and Prophetic books in the Bible.

MATH 5 – BJU PRESS

Students will be challenged to apply their knowledge of operations on whole numbers to decimals and fractions. They will also continue to develop pre-algebra skills and deepen their understanding of geometry, measurement, and data.

ENGLISH 5 – EASY GRAMMAR

READING 5 – BJU PRESS

Students will be equipped to enjoy lifelong reading, analyze and interpret texts in various genres, evaluate all they read from a biblical worldview, and become effective communicators.

SCIENCE 5 – BJU PRESS

Students will explore God's creation by studying minerals, rocks, fossils, matter and heat, sound and light, weather, ecosystems, and respiratory and circulatory systems.

6TH GRADE CURRICULUM

BIBLE 6: WINNING THE RACE – POSITIVE ACTION FOR CHRIST

Students will review essential New Testament doctrines and discuss how God strengthened various biblical figures to run their race.

MATH 6 – BJU PRESS
